DRESS CODE

DRESS CODE In accordance with the policy of the Wagoner Board of Education, the following regulation shall establish a dress and grooming code for the public school system.

Generally, students should regard neatness and cleanliness in grooming and clothing as important. Dress or grooming which is any way disruptive to the operations of the school will not be permitted. It is philosophy of the Wagoner Board of Education that student dress should reflect a business, rather than a leisure atmosphere.

Principals, in conjunction with sponsors, coaches, or other persons in charge of extracurricular activities, may regulate dress and grooming of students who participate in a particular activity, if the principal reasonably believes that the student's dress or grooming creates a hazard, or may prevent, interfere with, or adversely affect the purpose, direction, or effort required for the activity to achieve its goals.

If a student's dress or grooming is objectionable under the above provisions, school administrators, teachers, sponsors, or other staff designees shall take disciplinary action.

Students who violate provisions of the dress code shall be disciplined accordingly to policies described in the student handbook. In extreme cases, students may be suspended from school until the violation is corrected.

1. Clothing must conceal undergarments which are not appropriate for public view, at all times.
2. Hats, caps, sunglasses, other head coverings, (bandannas, head scarves, hoods, or hoodie tops, etc.), or unnatural hair color, (blue, green, purple etc.) are not to be worn in the building.
3. All bottoms must be khaki, dark black or regular blue jeans. They must be an appropriate fit for the student. No big pockets or slacking will be allowed. They may choose capris, slacks, long length shorts, skirts, or skorts. Skirts or skorts must be middle of the knee length. No cargo or carpenter pants. All clothes must be hemmed and not frayed.
4. Clothes must be solid in color, no stripes or visible labels. Regardless of color, windpants, sweats, flannel, or leather bottoms will not be permitted. They should be cotton or cotton blend.
5. Tops must be solid in color. They may be short or long sleeved. No mesh, etc, must not be able to see through.
 - A. Sweat shirt (solid in color)
 - B. Crew-neck t-shirts with or without pockets
 - C. Henley-polo style shirts long or short sleeved
 - D. Wagoner Middle School attire approved by Principal

- E. Team shirts or spirit shirts will be permissible. They will be allowed any day of the week.
 - F. Spirit days will be every Thursday. Students may wear any color of a school related shirt or regular school attire.
 - G. Shirts must be kept tucked at all times. Each violation will result in 1 hr detention. Teams will decide and recommend defiance to principal on repeat offenders.
6. Outerwear; such as jackets, coats, vests, and sweaters may not be worn in the hallways or class. They must be kept in students lockers. Belts are recommended but are not required. All shirts must be tucked in, with exceptions cleared through the Principal's office.
 7. No flip flops, house shoes, or skate shoes will be allowed. Shoes must fit properly for safety reasons. Sandals will be allowed if secured by strap.
 8. Knee socks must be plain black or white in color.
 9. Lettering, signs, slogans, jewelry, or other accessories that promote gangs or gang-related activities or which are innuendos, or which promotes violence, illicit or illegal behavior or activities, including alcohol, tobacco, and/or drug representations or advertisements are prohibited at school and school activities.
 10. Hairstyles (exotic colors)/jewelry, or other body jewelry of piercing and makeup-these and other accessory fashion styles or items should not cause a distraction in the school environment with exotic colors, height/width,

No student will be denied attendance at school, penalized or otherwise subject to compliance measures for failing to wear dress code clothes by reason of financial hardship. If any parent believes that they will be unable to provide for their child with the attire outlined in the dress code due to financial hardship, they should contact the school Principal.

Dress code will be in effect on the first day of school. Students who are not in compliance with the dress code will be asked to change into the proper attire. No student will be allowed into class without correct clothing. Parents may bring the proper attire. If able, the school will assist in providing the student with proper clothing.

1st Violation- Warning

2nd Violation- 1 hr detention

3rd Violation- 1 hr detention

4th Violation- 3 days of INT

5th Violation- 3 days of OSS

****Any further violation will be treated as Defiance of Authority.**

Exceptions to the above regulations for physical, health, religious, or other necessary conditions, may be made at the discretion of the site administrator or central administration or their designees after conferring with a student and his/her parents or legal guardians.
